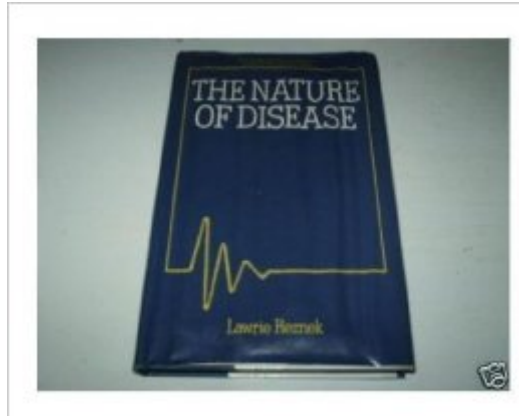


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The Nature Of Disease (Philosophical Issues In Science)



Synopsis

What is a disease? Are the social services right not to see smoking as a disease, and therefore to refuse to pay for its treatment? Should dissidents be diagnosed as mentally ill? Dr Reznek examines these and related questions.

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Resnek argues that disease is value laden, and provides plenty of historical examples to motivate this argument. He has two main arguments. One is that disease is not a natural kind, and thus is not purely a matter of scientific investigation. The second is that we designate certain conditons as diseases *before* we know anything about the organic cause, if any, and that we do this on the basis of the *harm* that comes to one who has the disease in question (which is a value judgement).
