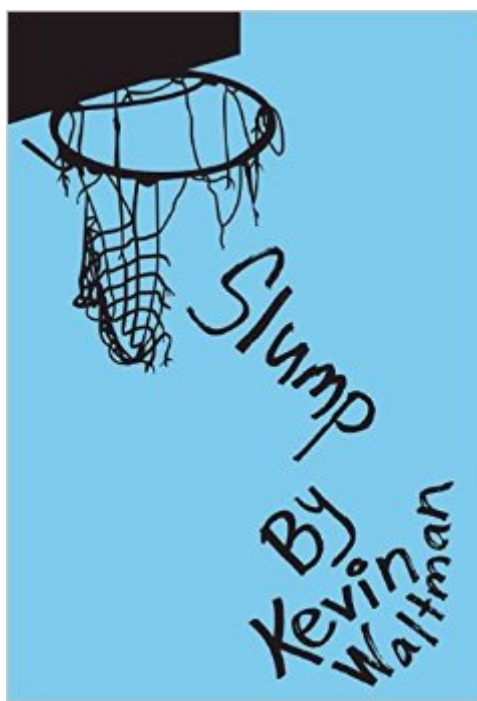

Slump is the second book in this series of books by Kevin Waltman. In this story, Derrick is returning to school at Marion East. He is still in a deep relationship with his girlfriend, Jasmine. While awaiting the beginning of basketball season, he hopes that his team will be successful. Worst case scenario,

a key player gets injured and the chemistry between the team is not as it should be, and that just happens. On the other hand, Bowen is handling personal issues of his own. Derrick's best friend of many years has begun to give more time and attention towards his girlfriend, then towards Derrick. Also, his relationship with Jasmine is on the line due to complications with basketball and sexual activity. In addition, Derrick's father had been in a nearly fatal accident, which resulted in rehabilitation. Since the accident, the family's financial situation is not doing so well. Earlier in the year, Derrick was given the opportunity to go to a private high school, where his dad would be given a job. He declined the offer and chose to stay at Marion East. Now, he is beginning to regret his decision. Although, he reminds himself that at the end of it all, with hard work, determination, and excellence, he can overcome these obstacles. Slump is the second book in a series by author Kevin Waltman. Here is a brief synopsis of the first book. In Indiana, basketball is the next thing to religion. Unfortunately, a player gets injured and the team is having trouble connecting and working together. Derrick's personal situation isn't doing so great either. His best friend isn't really there for him and his relationship with Jasmine is on edge due to issues regarding sex. On top of that, his father was in an accident and needs rehabilitation.
